Additional Classes Available - State Fire Schools - Auto extrication, basic fire pump ops, heavy truck extrication, leadership I, leadership II, fire behavior, On-scene fire investigation, perp for initial company ops, special rescue, training officer roles and responsibilities, water rescue, wilderness search and rescue, basic medical care, ethanol emergencies, RIT scenarios, FF 1 cert, haz mat ops review, instructor 1 review, documenting the incident MFIRS, highway incident management awareness, rescue from storage bins and silos, thermal imaging units, vehicle extrication for the 21st century, active shooter, perimeters & IED response, arson awareness, electricity and firefighters, top 10 scene mistakes and how to avoid them, etc.

These classes generally are about \$100 for a 12 hour class, \$80 for a 8 hour class, \$65 for a 4 hour class.

Clarifications

Hennipin County Technical College (HCTC)
